A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CITY OF TROUTDALE TO AUTHORIZE FAIRVIEW CONTRIBUTION TO A FIRE SERVICE STUDY CONDUCTED BY PORTLAND STATE UNIVERSITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Gresham Fire Department contracted with Fairview, Troutdale, and Wood Village to provide fire services to the area; and

WHEREAS, the contract for fire services expires June 30, 2015, and is subject to renegotiation or termination; and

WHEREAS, exploration of viable service delivery alternatives will assist Fairview in determining the appropriate actions to take concerning this agreement and other potential service delivery methods; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has engaged Portland State University to conduct a study to evaluate service delivery options for fire services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview has determined it desires to participate in this study along with the Cities of Troutdale and Wood Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. The City Administrator is authorized to sign a Memorandum of Understanding, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A", to conduct a fire services evaluation through the Mark O. Hatfield School of Government, Center for Public Service, Portland State University.
