



**RESOLUTION**  
**(51 - 2014)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW  
AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-15  
BUDGET.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview has unanticipated expenses related to a Fairview Easter Egg Hunt event; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview has unanticipated expenses related sidewalk repairs of Village Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview has unanticipated expenses related Stormwater System MS4 permit requirements requiring additional professional contract services; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget changes provided herein do not change any fund by 10% or more from the adopted Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-15 Budget and in fact only transfers current allocations within the General Fund and not across funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the changes to the FY 2014-15 Budget as proposed here do not impact the total authorized expenditures of any fund; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution to accept the transfer of budgeted appropriations within the City of Fairview FY 2014-15 Budget is necessary to continue to manage distribution of those resources and expenditures and to maintain compliance with ORS 294.471(3)(a) and 294.463.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1** The Fairview City Council hereby authorizes the FY 2014-15 transfers of appropriations as set forth below.

- A.** The City Council received more donations than anticipated for an Easter Egg event held in 2014 resulting in an unanticipated donation amount for a 2015 Easter event remaining at Fiscal year end, attached here as Exhibit A totaling \$487. To effectuate this change, the Fairview City Council hereby authorizes the following transfer of appropriations in the FY 2014-15 Budget:

- B.** To cover additional expenses related to the Sidewalk Repair Assistance Program the Fairview City Council hereby authorizes the following transfer of appropriations in the FY 2014-15 Budget:

Contingency     (\$ 25,000)

- C.** To meet the unanticipated requirements of the city's Stormwater System MS4 Permit, the Fairview City Council authorizes the following transfer of appropriations in the FY 2014-15 Budget:


