This is a public meeting where deliberation of the Budget Committee will take place. The meeting will be continued to the following dates and times unless subsequently noticed: Monday, April 20, 2015, 6:30 PM and Monday, April 27, 2015, 6:30 PM.

Public Comment will be received by the Budget Committee on Monday, April 20, 2015, 6:30 PM at Fairview City Hall, 1300 NE Village Street, Fairview, Oregon 97024. Any person may appear at the meeting and discuss the proposed programs with the Budget Committee.





On March 24th the Troutdale City Council voted to approve a law-enforcement contract with the Multnomah County Sheriff’s Office. They have been in negotiations for the past year, and with that concluded, I expect Sheriff Stanton will want to see if Fairview will consider contracting for law enforcement services from the County as well. Currently, with Wood Village and now Troutdale, it would seem logical the three cities could be served by the Sheriff’s Office. With that in mind, I am going to have two community meetings in Fairview City Hall Council Chambers to present a slide show presentation from the Sheriff’s Office and receive public input. These meetings are scheduled for April 29th and May 19th at 6:30 PM. I urge you to attend and let your City Council know your feelings on this important issue.

Spring Clean Up Time

To encourage spring cleanup, 12 Mile Disposal customers will be allowed the equivalent of five, 30-gallon trash cans free of charge on their regular trash pick-up day during the week of May 18th. Also, the City of Fairview has arranged with Allwood Recyclers, at no cost to you, for residents to drop off up to two cubic yards of yard debris during the month of May 2015. (No sod or dirt will be accepted). Allwood Recyclers is located at 23001 NE Marine Drive in Fairview. Residents must present a coupon and Fairview identification to be eligible. Look for the Allwood coupon in May’s Fairview Point.
