Seeking Applications for Fairview City Council

The Fairview City Council consists of a Mayor and six Councilors elected from the city at large. Council Position Number Four (4) is currently vacant. Qualified residents may apply for the vacancy by submitting an application for appointment by the remaining Council members. To qualify, candidates must be a qualified voter and have resided in the city for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment. Applications must be received by the Office of the City Recorder no later than 5:00 PM on Tuesday, May 26, 2015.



Fairview City Council will conduct interviews of qualified candidates and will appoint the successful candidate. The appointed candidate will be sworn in immediately following the Council's decision. It is anticipated the above process will occur in early to mid-June.

Per the City of Fairview Charter, the newly appointed Councilor will hold Council Position Number Four (4) until December 31, 2016. The remainder of the Council Position term will be subject to the November 2016 general election process and results.

Also, the City of Fairview has arranged with Allwood Recyclers, at no cost to you, for residents to drop off up to two cubic yards of yard debris during the month of May 2015. (No sod or dirt will be accepted). Allwood Recyclers is located at 23001 NE Marine Drive in Fairview. Residents must present a coupon and Fairview identification to be eligible.

Mayor's Thoughts...The 45th anniversary of "Earth Day" was April 22, 2015 and this year's theme was "It's Our Turn to Lead." Earth Day got its start in the U.S. to increase public awareness of environmental problems. About 20 million people took part in the inaugural earth day in 1970, taking to the streets and parks to demonstrate for environmental causes. Fairview Budget Committee Approves FY 2015-16 Budget

With a unanimous vote, the Fairview Budget Committee of 13 citizens (6 of which are also members of the City Council) approved the \$18.2 million Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget.

The budget reflects the city's improving financial position and methodical and cautious re-instatement and expansion of programs and services.

A citizen budget summary will be available in mid-May with additional details.

A copy of the approved budget will be available on the city website on May 6, 2015. The City Council will consider adoption of the approved budget at its June 17, 2015 meeting.
