**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING METRO
POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (MPAC) REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE
FOR 2015 AND 2016.**

WHEREAS, the Metro Policy Advisory Committee (MPAC) advises the Metro Council on growth management and land use issues at the policy level; and

WHEREAS, MPAC is a charter-mandated committee made up of 6 non-voting members and 21 voting members of which one position represents the four smaller cities of Multnomah County including Fairview, Wood Village, Troutdale, and Maywood Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mayors and Councils have agreed to reappoint Wood Village City Councilor Tim Clark to represent the cities on MPAC with Fairview City Councilor Brian Cooper as the designated alternate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 The City Council hereby confirms the appointment of Wood Village City Councilor Tim Clark as the MPAC Representative and Fairview City Councilor Brian Cooper as the alternate for the years of 2015 and 2016.
