**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY'S SELECTION OF THE TOP FOUR
LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES TO FORWARD TO THE LEAGUE OF OREGON CITIES**

WHEREAS, the League of Oregon Cities (LOC) goes through a process of developing legislative priorities for the upcoming elections and legislative sessions and gives cities an opportunity to help identify its legislative priorities for the next couple of years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council had an opportunity to review the 29 legislative objectives brought forward by the eight LOC policy committees at their July 6 work session and identified the following as their top four priorities:

- M. Restore Recreational Immunity;
- Q. Remove Qualification Based Selection Mandate;
- S. PERS Reforms; and
- V. Protect Right of Way Control; and

WHEREAS, The City Council requests their top four priorities be submitted to the League of Oregon Cities no later than the deadline of July 22, 2016.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 The City Administrator will, on behalf of the Fairview City Council, submit the top four legislative priorities as listed above to the League of Oregon Cities by the July 22, 2016 deadline.
