**A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS DUE TO THE  
CONSOLIDATION OF THE FAIRVIEW POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH THE  
MULTNOMAH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND SUBSEQUENT VEHICLE SALE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to comply with Oregon Budget Law; and

**WHEREAS**, OAR 294.338(3) allows for an increase in appropriations for unanticipated non-tax revenue via resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the City realized unanticipated revenues of \$214,660 for the sale of police vehicles to the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1** The City Council hereby authorizes the following proposed budget appropriations resolution to the FY2017-18 Budget:
