A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL DECLARING THE MAIN FLOOR OF THE FAIRVIEW COMMUNITY CENTER TO BE NAMED THE “BETTY GALLAGHER ROOM”

WHEREAS, Betty Gallagher has worked for the City of Fairview in various capacities for approximately 32 years; and

WHEREAS, the building now known as the Fairview Community Center located at 300 Harrison Street served as Fairview City Hall until the year 2000; and

WHEREAS, a large portion of Ms. Gallagher’s time working for the City was spent at the Community Center while it served as City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the main level and basement level of the Fairview Community Center have not been named and are currently known as the “main level” and “basement level”; and

WHEREAS, the Fairview City Council wishes to acknowledge Ms. Gallagher’s service to the City of Fairview and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 The “main level” of the Fairview Community Center will be named the “Betty Gallagher Room” in recognition of Ms. Gallagher’s service to the City of Fairview and its citizens. A plaque is to be purchased and installed indicating such.

Section 2 This resolution is and shall be effective from and after the day of its passage.
