

**RESOLUTION**  
**(20-2011)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL  
ADOPTING THE 2010 WATER MASTER PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Oregon's Department of Human Services conducted a Sanitary Survey in 2009 and found the current 20-year Capital Improvement Plan was soon to expire, and

**WHEREAS**, Oregon Administrative Rule 333-061-0060 requires community water systems with 300 or more service connections maintain current master plans that have been reviewed and approved by the State Department of Human Services, and

**WHEREAS**, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act's loan to the City included \$50,000 to be spent on a Asset Management Plan and field data collection equipment, and

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into a Personal Services Agreement with PACE Engineers, Inc. for the engineering services associated with the plan, and

**WHEREAS**, the 2010 Water Master Plan serves as an update to the 1989 Master Plan and several subsequent Capital Improvement Project Updates and represents a twenty year planning horizon, and


**WHEREAS**, the Department of Human Services Drinking Water Program reviewed and approved the 2010 Water Master Plan January 27, 2011.

**Section 1.** The Fairview City Council approves the 2010 Water Master Plan.


**Section 2.** This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.
