

RESOLUTION

(29-2011)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, OREGON ESTABLISHING PARKING LIMITATIONS ALONG A SECTION OF GLISAN STREET WEST OF FAIRVIEW PARKWAY.

WHEREAS, after review and consultation with the Fairview Police Chief, Fairview Public Works Director, Multnomah County Engineer, and a the city's traffic consultant, DKS and Associates, the City determined that unregulated parking along Glisan Street creates unsafe conditions and leads to higher accident risks because of site restrictions and conflicts caused by vehicles backing out into the travel lanes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard complaints of property owners at the Cottages at Salish Ponds about nighttime truck parking and related noise and activity on Glisan Street; and

WHEREAS, Glisan Street within the City of Fairview is under the general road jurisdiction of Multnomah County in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 368; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview is the road authority for Glisan Street with respect to parking in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes 810.010; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized to establish parking areas, time limitations, and manner of parking pursuant to Fairview Municipal Code 10.05.040; and

WHEREAS, the Fairview Transportation System Plan designates Glisan as a major arterial and the Multnomah County Design Standards designate Glisan as a major collector; and

WHEREAS, the future build out for Glisan Street as shown in the Fairview Transportation System Plan (Figure 8-4), and Multnomah County Design Standards does not provide on street parking; and

WHEREAS, the Multnomah County Design Standards Section 2.2.7 prohibit parking on major collectors when not located within a fully developed central business district; and

WHEREAS, Fairview Municipal Code Section 10.05.080 authorizes the Fairview Police Officers designated by the City Council to enforce the provisions of Chapter 10.05 Uniform Traffic Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, restricting parking along Glisan Street from Fairview Parkway west to the city limits is necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare due to traffic conditions along Glisan Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Fairview as follows:


- Section 1.** Parking along Glisan Street is prohibited from NE Fairview Parkway west to the City Limits. The City Council hereby designates all officers of the Fairview Police Department to enforce this parking prohibition.
- Section 2.** This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.
