**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING SUBMISSION OF A
TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT APPLICATION FOR USE IN
UPDATING THE CITY'S TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN**

WHEREAS, Metro Council approved the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan which including the Regional Transportation Functional Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Functional Plan is the regulatory base to which Fairview's Transportation System Plan (TSP) must respond, and

WHEREAS, Fairview has until December 2012 to demonstrate the City's TSP complies with the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan, and

WHEREAS, Fairview last updated the Transportation System Plan in June 1999 and an update is needed to meet the requirements of the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan and the City is without funds to prepare such an update , and


WHEREAS, Metro offers financial grants to assist with the cost of updating the City's TSP so as to be in compliance with the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan and city staff believes it appropriate to apply for such a grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW
AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to submit an application to Metro for a Transportation and Growth Management Grant thereby allowing the City to update the City's Transportation System Plan to effect compliance with Metro's 2035 Regional Transportation Plan.

Section 2. This Resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.



The City's Transportation System Plan (TSP) was last updated in June 1999, and now is the best time for the City to revise the TSP. I very much appreciate the opportunity to apply for grant assistance from ODOT to assess our transportation system needs and make important updates to our plan.
