

**RESOLUTION**

**(17-2012)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW, OREGON  
AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-12 BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview City Administrator has authorized the City to enter into a contract with JW Underground to abate a nuisance structure at 20939 NE Halsey Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the expense of \$18,360 for this abatement was not anticipated in the budget for FY 2011-12; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview wishes to transfer appropriations from contingency in the General Fund for unanticipated expenses for nuisance abatement; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget changes provided herein do not change the fund by 10% or more from the FY 2011-12 adopted budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget transfer would be from Contingency and does not exceed 15% of the total appropriations in the fund;

**WHEREAS**, a resolution to transfer budgeted appropriations within the City of Fairview Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Budget is necessary to continue to manage distribution of those expenditures and to maintain compliance with ORS 294.450;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1.** The Fairview City Council hereby authorizes the following FY 2011-12 appropriation changes:

<u>General Fund</u>		
110-15-6690601	Abatement Expense	\$18,360
110-40-6910000	Contingency	(\$18,360)

**Section 2.** The General Fund transfer described above ensures appropriation categories are maintained in compliance with Oregon Budget Law. The purpose of the authorized expenditure is abatement of a nuisance structure at 20939 NE Halsey Street, Fairview, Oregon.

**Section 3.** This Resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.


