**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW  
ENDORING THE EAST METRO CONNECTIONS PLAN RECOMMENDATIONS  
AND ACTION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into a memorandum of understanding in 2007 to advance a comprehensive corridor study for East Multnomah County for the areas between I-84 and US 26 as well as east/west connectivity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Memorandum of Understanding obligated the Fairview, along with other East County jurisdictions, to provide necessary local match money to fund the transportation corridor study identified as the East Metro Connections Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Metro Connections Plan was guided by the following goals: support connectivity between I-84 and US 26, as well as east/west connectivity and capacity in the East Metro plan area; make the best use of the existing transportation system; develop multiple solutions that encompass all transportation modes; foster economic vitality; distribute both benefits and burdens of growth; enhance the livability and safety of East Metro communities; ensure that East Metro is a place where people want to live, work and play; support the local land use vision of each community; and enhance the natural environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Metro Connections Plan has evaluated regionally significant transportation investments for access and mobility, safety, economic development, healthy communities, equity, natural environment and feasibility; and prioritized the projects based on current and future needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Metro Connections Plan has identified the needs, transportation mode, function, scope and general location for solutions needed for regionally significant transportation investments between now and the year 2035 for the areas south of I-84; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Metro Connections Plan has identified regionally significant transportation investments to promote north/south connectivity between US 26 and I-84; and projects to promote economic development and job creation; and projects to promote regional mobility; and

**WHEREAS**, current and future transportation needs are served by implementing the investments identified in the East Metro Connections Plan recommendation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City endorses the East Metro Connections Plan Recommendation and Action Plan attached as Exhibit "B".

**Section 2.** The City specifically recognizes the competition among regions for scarce transportation resources, and the need to develop mutually supportive projects to successfully achieve the financing necessary for construction.


Within the geographic boundaries applicable to the East Metro Connections Plan, the City agrees to promote and mutually support identified projects from the plan once approved at the county coordinating level.

**Section 3.** The City acknowledges projects of importance to the City may emerge in areas included in, and not included in, the plan area of the East Metro Connections Plan. The City agrees to notify all Multnomah County City and County organizations of the intent to compete for resources for any such project.

**Section 4.** The City, through this endorsement, encourages the final adoption of the plan by Metro, and the inclusion of all plan elements into the Regional Transportation Plan, and subsequently all local transportation system plans.

**Section 5.** This Resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.


