**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF THE  
MT. HOOD COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOND MEASURE**

**WHEREAS**, the residents of the Mt. Hood Community College District will vote on a bond measure on May 17, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$125-million bond will work toward enhancing workforce development efforts in this district and throughout the Greater Portland Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the bond will leverage an additional \$8-million in Oregon state funds for the building of a new Advanced Workforce and Applied Technology Center; and

**WHEREAS**, this effort will provide for increased efforts in the safety and security of the students, staff, faculty, and community members on the college campus; and

**WHEREAS**, a new Maywood Park campus will be constructed to better serve residents within the district by providing a full-service campus that will offer career pathways leading to employment possibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the college currently has no bond debt; and

**WHEREAS**, Mt. Hood Community College has played a vital role in our community for nearly 50-years providing great educational opportunities, has been a major employer of local residents and adds greatly to the economic vitality of our area; and

**WHEREAS**, this bond will result in even greater educational opportunities that will lead to jobs for our residents;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**


