**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF DESIGN SERVICES FOR A BIKE-PED ACCESS UNDER THE 223<sup>RD</sup> RAILROAD BRIDGE NORTH OF SANDY BOULEVARD NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000**

**WHEREAS**, 223<sup>rd</sup> Avenue is a County road, with a Union Pacific railroad crossing above it; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for a bicycle-pedestrian access under the Union Pacific railroad bridge on 223<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, north of Sandy Boulevard; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fairview has agreed to provide the funding and project management for the design of bicycle-pedestrian facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City purchasing rules only authorize the City Administrator to enter into agreements less than \$50,000 without Council approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1**      The Fairview City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to enter into a contract for professional services for the work under the 223<sup>rd</sup> Railroad Bridge, with the selected consultant in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.

**Section 2**      This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the City Council.
