



RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING TWELVE-MILE DISPOSAL SERVICE, INC. TO CHARGE ITS CUSTOMERS THE PASS-THROUGH COST FOR THE CORPORATE ACTIVITY TAX (CAT) BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2020

WHEREAS, Twelve-Mile Disposal Service, Inc. was granted a solid waste license for the collection of solid waste and recyclable material within the City of Fairview with an expiration of December 2029; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon implemented a Corporate Activity Tax beginning January 1, 2020 that Twelve-Mile Disposal is subject to; and

WHEREAS, FMC Section 8.20.175 requires Council approval in order for the licensee to pass through incurred costs to the licensee's customers; and

WHEREAS, Twelve-Mile Disposal has requested approval of an additional line item charge to customers monthly bills for the CAT to begin June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, per FMC Section 8.20.135(F) rates shall be reviewed by the city every two years, with the last review and approved rate increase occurring in May 2018; and

WHEREAS, Twelve-Mile Disposal requests the 2020 rate review be delayed one to two years to allow more accurate data on revenue and expenses to be provided, including the CAT and pending rate increase imposed by Metro, for the next review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1 The Fairview City Council approves Twelve-Mile Disposal, Inc. to implement an additional line item charge on customers monthly bills for the Corporate Activity Tax beginning June 1, 2020.

Section 2 The Council grants the rate review extension for up to two years.


Section 2 This resolution is and shall be effective from the day of its passage.
